BRANDERBEE LTD ("us", "we", or "our") uses cookies on www.branderbee.com (the "Service"). By using the Service, you consent to the use of cookies.

Our Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how we use cookies, how third-parties we may partner with may use cookies on the Service, your choices regarding cookies and further information about cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of text sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the Service or a third-party to recognize you and make your next visit easier and the Service more useful to you.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.

How BRANDERBEE LTD uses cookies

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser. We use cookies for the following purposes: to enable certain functions of the Service, to provide analytics.

Google cookies

BRANDERBEE LTD uses Google Analytics to analyse the use of the website. Google Analytics generates statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store and use this information. Third-party cookies

The cookies we use on www.branderbee.com are used to log visitors' behaviour patterns, enabling BRANDERBEE LTD to analyse the performance of the web content we offer. We do not use cookies to collect personal data (ie. data that could be used to identify living individuals). In addition, the cookies only apply to the actual session in which they are used, and do not store any settings or preferences for future sessions. They are also intended exclusively for first party use, which means that only www.branderbee.com has access to them, and they do not provide access to any third parties, such as advertising networks or other companies.
